SUMMER READING

Read every day. Some days you can read to your child or they can read to you or you can do a shared reading.

WRITING

Your child should write an entry in a writing journal at least once a week. Entries should be at least three sentences.

They can write about anything such as vacations, summer activities or books they have read. One drawing per entry may be included. The journal book will be due on the first day of school. It will be graded, based on completion, and entered as a test grade.

MATH

Students need to practice the following skills:

- Counting ordinal numbers (1-100)
- Counting by 2's, 5's, and 10's

OTHER EXPECTATIONS

Please practice the following with your children before they enter first grade.

1. Writing numbers in order from 1 to 50
2. Spelling first and last names correctly
3. Phone numbers
4. Tying shoes
5. Letters and sounds
